

## What information will SPSU release about me without my consent?

The only information that SPSU will release without your consent is that which has been specifically designated as “directory” information. Directory information is designated so that we can verify your enrollment if, for example, you apply for a loan or your insurance company needs to verify your enrollment. If we were not allowed to confirm your enrollment, we would have to tell ANYONE who asks that we cannot confirm your attendance. That could create some real problems for you. So, we have designated the follow items as directory information and will tell anyone who asks:

- student's name
- place of birth
- class schedule
- current enrollment status
- dates of attendance
- major field of study
- participation in officially recognized activities and sports
- degrees and awards received
- hometown
- weight and height of
- members of athletic teams
- prior college(s) attended

If you do not want directory information released, you have the right to prevent it by notifying us in writing that you do not wish directory information to be released. You do not have the right to choose which items to release and which to restrict. You can only choose to allow it to be released or not.

Be VERY careful if you decide to restrict the release of directory information. If you restrict it, we will neither confirm nor deny that we know anything about you, no matter who asks us.

Notice that we do not classify any contact data as directory information.
